## Children's Book Bundles Coming Soon!

### What Are Book Bundles?

Book Bundles are a quick and convenient way for you to pick up several children's books on a topic that may interest your child. For instance, for the topic of "Things that Go", we might bundle together *My Car* by Byron Barton, *Thomas the Tank Engine's Big Yellow Treasury* by Christopher Awdry, and World Book's *Tough Trucks*. If your child loves anything about puppies, you might choose a bundle which has *Jump, Pup!* by Susan Neuman, *My Puppy Is Born* by Joanna Cole, and *The Pokey Little Puppy* by Janette Sebring Lowrey. The key to book bundles is that library staff will have already located books on a similar topic and bundled them together. All you have to do is select the bundle and

check it out. Be watching the children's room for the appearance of Book Bundles!
